

PLANNING GUIDE FOR SENIORS

FALL

- ACT test dates are September 14 & October 26
- Continue to gather college information & narrow your choices
- Apply for appropriate national & state scholarships
- Complete NCAA initial eligibility center paperwork for Division I & II athletics, if necessary
- Register for a Federal Student Aid ID at <https://fsaid.ed.gov> – both student and one parent need an FSA ID
- Begin college applications
- Some early decision apps have late October/early November deadlines
- College night at Wooster High School is September 30
- Meeting for Parents of College-Bound Seniors/Financial Aid is October 15
- FAFSA can be filed beginning October 1 at <https://fafsa.ed.gov>

WINTER

- ACT test dates are December 14 & February 8
- Continue applying for scholarships
- Complete NCAA initial eligibility center paperwork for Division I & II athletics, if necessary
- It is best, for your own planning purposes, that you have applied to your college choices before THS December break
- Local scholarship information becomes available after winter break

SPRING

- ACT test dates are April 4, June 13 & July 18
- Continue applying for scholarships
- Complete NCAA initial eligibility center paperwork for Division I & II athletics, if necessary
- Many colleges require a deposit by May 1
